Fire Officer III to Chief Fire Officer will end in 2015:

What is the new "Chief Fire Officer Certification?"

This program replaces the Fire Officer III Program and meets the requirements for OSFM certification at the newly established Chief Fire Officer level. This program meets all the requirements at the N.F.P.A. Fire Officer III and IV level. The program is designed and intended for Command level officers and/or Administrators who have the responsibilities of supervising and administering a Fire Department or Fire District. Officers preparing for a Chief level position are encouraged to apply.

Fire service personnel currently certified at the Fire Officer III level wishing to attain Chief Fire Officer certification will need to meet the requirements of the new standard. For most, completion of the Life Safety Initiative's class and re-application will satisfy this requirement.

Once this class is completed and the objectives are fulfilled, an application for Chief Fire Officer must be submitted.

The class is a one day classroom session followed by on-line requirements for the remainder of the month. Once completed the candidate must complete the application and send it in for review.
