## **(IL-AFAA) ILLINOIS FIRE ALARM ASSOCIATION**

The IL-AFAA is an advocate, not-for-profit trade association serving the fire alarm and smoke detection industry. This includes promoting code compliant installations, advocating through and proper inspection and tests, working with legislative bodies in the development of ordinances, promoting automatic fire detection as an integral part of a balanced fire protection solutions. Using the correct technology for the application whether it is smoke detectors, fire sprinklers, fire extinguishers or passive fire protection through proper building materials.

To improve professionalism in our industry by providing quality training through seminars and educational programs, webinars, and online training that will benefit the growth of your business and a platform for networking. And sharing issues and advocating for improvement of our industry. To provide a voice for the industry on a local level by developing relationships with local AHJ's, designers, and other trade associations.

## **(IFIA) ILLINOIS FIRE INSPECTORS ASSOCIATION**

The Illinois Fire Inspectors Association (IFIA) has been serving Illinois Fire Departments since 1967, by offering education activities to Code Enforcers, Public Educators, and Fire Investigators. IFIA's mission is to reduce death and injuries from fire and other dangers through education, enforcement and engineering.

Training and conferences are not the only ways IFIA works at their mission. We are active in legislation both at the State and Federal levels. We were instrumental in smoke detector legislation, fire safe cigarette legislation, and legislation prohibiting security devices to look like life safety devices (i.e., sprinklers, smoke detectors, etc.).

We are active in code development at the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), and International Code Council levels, as well as supporting other organizations with similar goals such as the Illinois Fire Alarm Association (IL-AFAA), National Fire Sprinkler Association just to name a few. Some of the agencies we work closely with and support are the Salvation Army, the Shriners Hospital, and "I Am Me" (burn camp).

### **“I Am Me” Burn Camp**

The “I Am Me” Burn Camp is a non-profit camp overseen by the Illinois Fire Safety Alliance which is dedicated to Fire Safety, Burn Prevention, and Supporting Burn Survivors. Hundreds of children in Illinois every year suffer from scalding, chemical and flame burns. The Fire Alliance provides education about fire and burn safety. The camp tracks the type of burns because in order to provide services to meet their camper’s needs. Besides the typical camp activities, the children also participate in the “Challenger Program”, which promotes character development by challenging the campers to accept and demonstrate positive values. They learn to engage in journal and therapeutic activities which reflects their lives before and after they were burned and to enhance their future healing process. There is approximately 65 volunteers that organize and work at the 300 acre YMCA Camp located in Duncan, Illinois. They include current and former Firefighter’s Nurses, Teachers, Older Teens, and Adults that are former Campers.

### **The Chromosome 18 Registry & Research Society - “A Hole-in-One for Hannah”**

The Chromosome 18 Registry & Research Society is a lay advocacy organization composed primarily of individuals with a chromosome 18 abnormality. We consist of three separate organizations located in the United States, Australia, and Europe, all with a common mission: To help people with chromosome 18 abnormalities overcome the obstacles they face so they may lead a happy, healthy and productive lives. One of every 180 babies is born with a chromosome abnormality, and there is currently no known cause or cure. It could happen to any child. Children born with chromosome 18 conditions, like children with Down syndrome or other chromosome changes, were at one time simply institutionalized. Medical advances in recent years have enabled us to better understand and treat these conditions, but there is still much more research to be done. We are proud to count among our members those who are affected by a chromosome 18 abnormality, extended family members, and professionals. Our work is supported by memberships and donations from individuals, businesses, and charitable organizations. Last year was our 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary, and we have met the strict criteria for fiscal responsibility set by the Combined Federal Campaign. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit, tax exempt public charity.
