- Under the age of 35 at the time of final eligibility posting. This age limitation does not apply to current or previously employed full-time Firefighter / Paramedics from municipalities within the State of Illinois (All other requirements apply).
- Valid CPAT card due at orientation. CPAT card considered valid only if dated between July 30, 2015 and July 30, 2016. Applicants who do not have a valid CPAT card should contact NIPSTA @ [www.nipsta.org](http://www.nipsta.org) (847) 998-8090 for testing dates.
- Applicants shall be certified as Illinois Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter and Emergency Medical Technician/Paramedic (EMT-P) at the time of application. Applicants must maintain and provide proof of their certification at orientation and original appointment.
- Residency in the Village of Lansing within six months after the probationary period.
- Successful completion of all phases of testing process.
